Sub: Discrepancies in revision of the rates of Stipend to the Apprentices and Trainees in the Railways
Ref.: Railway Board's letter No.PC-V/2016/PS/1(Stipend) dated 02.02.2017(RBE No.08/2017)

Orders for revision of rates of Stipend to Apprentices and Trainees in the Railways have been issued vide Board's letter under reference.


We found discrepancies in the revised rates made applicable to corresponding grade pay of 6th CPC pay structure in various pay levels of 7th CPC Pay Matrix.

It is seen that, comparative stipend for erstwhile GP of Rs.1900 has been fixed at Rs.19900, whereas in the case of Tech. Gr. III in Mechanical Department, the stipend has been fixed at Rs.18000. The corresponding rate of Stipend fixed for erstwhile GP Rs.4200 has been fixed at Rs.35400, whereas in the case of JE(Bridge), Commercial Apprentices, Asstt. Station Master, whose erstwhile grade pay has been upgraded to GP Rs.4200 by the 7th CPC and also in the case of Traffic Apprentices, stipend has been fixed at the reduced pay of Rs.29200.


The Board are, therefore, requested to make necessary corrections in their letter referred to above and circulate the same to all the Zonal Railways and Production Units.
